I love to sing and my dream is to perform on Broadway one day! But, when I was 13, I found out I had severe scoliosis, and I feared that dream would never become a reality.


Like many others, my scoliosis went unnoticed. Adults often say they remember scoliosis checks in school, but in 2007, Indiana stopped requiring these screenings.
